

LITURGY OF THE WORD

Dt 4:1-2. 6-8 Ps 14 Jm 1: 17-18.21-22.27 Mk 7:1-8. 14-15. 21-23

Back to Mark and a dispute about ritual washing. The Pharisees noticed that some of Jesus' disciples did not wash hands before eating. This was a rule passed down, not observed by all and even the instructions were unclear: literally, people were to 'wash their hands with the fist' and debates raged on what that meant! Jesus cuts through the argument: humans are made unclean by what exists within them: not by what they eat.

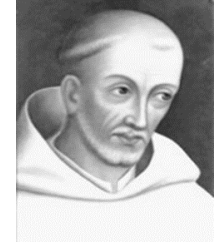
