

LITURGY OF THE WORD

Kgs 17: 10-16. Ps 145. Heb 9: 24-28. Mk 12: 38-44

Teaching in the Temple, Jesus notices two things. First, the wealthy make large donations to the Temple Treasury, which consisted of 13 bronze trumpet shaped receptacles, so everyone heard the sound of large donations, and saw their donors! Jesus sees a poor widow putting in her last penny and contrasts her with those who put in what was surplus. Her generosity is amazing, but is Jesus drawing attention to a corrupt system which took the woman's last penny?

PRAYER TO ST MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL

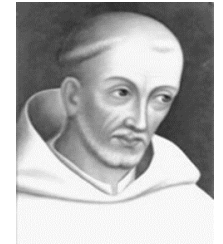
