Dn 7: 13-14. Ps 92. Rv 1: 5-8. In 18: 33-37

We turn to the gospel of John for this Solemnity and Jesus' trial before Pontius Pilate, who asks "Are you the King of the Jews?" Perhaps for the first time ever, the prisoner replies to Pilate with his own question! Jesus then clarifies what type of King he is: his kingdom is not of this world: he came to bear witness to the truth. We may Jesus' earlier word "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life!"


